AstraZeneca is a global biopharmaceutical company pushing the boundaries of science to discover and develop new life-changing medicines. Sustainability is part of our organizational DNA. By taking bold action on sustainability we are tackling some of the biggest challenges of our time, from climate change to access to healthcare and disease prevention – helping to create a healthier future for people, society, and the planet.

A Healthy Planet

AstraZeneca recognizes the connection between healthy people and a healthy environment, and has been recognized as a global corporate leader in fighting climate change. Through our progressive **Ambition Zero Carbon** strategy, we have committed to be zero carbon across Scope 1 and 2 emissions by the end of 2025.

The company has made significant progress to-date; reducing our Scope 1 and 2 greenhouse gases by 59% and, in 2021, 100% of our imported electricity came from renewable sources.

AZ Forest is an important part of our work to address climate change. The global program aims to plant and maintain 50M trees world-wide by the end of 2025, in partnership with local governments and non-profit organizations focused on reforestation. We're ahead of schedule, with programs in place to plant 45M trees worldwide. In Canada, we are proud to support **One Tree Planted** and the City of Mississauga's **One Million Trees** program.



Contributing to a Healthy Society

A founding partner of **The ACT Foundation**, we have donated more than \$2M to help ACT deliver CPR and defibrillator training – critical life-saving skills – to more than 3.5 million Canadian youth.

Through **Share & Care** – our employee charitable giving and match program – we are supporting 110 Canadian charities, including **Food Banks Canada**, **Kids Help Phone**, and the **Canadian Red Cross**.

Through AstraZeneca's Young Health Program we have donated \$8M to **At My Best**, a free school-based program delivered by **PHE Canada** to support emotional well-being, physical activity, and healthy eating in young children.

We have donated \$26M in needed medicines and financial assistance through **Health Partners International of Canada** to support disaster relief and humanitarian efforts around the world – including in Burkina Faso, Ethiopia, Haiti, India, and Ukraine.

Contributing to Healthy People

The global COVID-19 pandemic has had a huge impact on human health. Together with our global partners, AstraZeneca has supplied more than **3 billion vaccine doses to over 180 countries**. Approximately **two-thirds of this supply has gone to low- and middle-income countries**, part of our commitment to providing broad and equitable access to our vaccine.

AstraZeneca has **helped more than 20,000 Canadians access our medicines**, including providing early access to new medical innovations through a Special Access Program for patients with serious or life-threatening conditions.

Partnering with Canexia Health and the Digital Technology Supercluster, we are funding and supporting more than 2,000 rapid diagnostic tests for Canadians suspected of having lung cancer – strengthening early cancer screening and diagnosis capabilities.
